The agenda includes updates and important actions regarding the Land Conservation Program and other matters.

The Board may consider taking action on multiple items, including the following matters:

Board Adoption of Land Conservation and Conveyance Plans:

SHASTA COUNTY:

Adoption of the proposed Land Conservation and Conveyance Plan for land to be donated to the United States Forest Service at the Battle Creek planning unit.

Adoption of the proposed Land Conservation and Conveyance Plan for land to be donated to the United States Forest Service at the Lake Britton planning unit.

BUTTE COUNTY:

Adoption of the proposed Land Conservation and Conveyance Plan for land to be retained by PG&E at the Philbrook planning unit.

No Significant Public Interest Value

SHASTA COUNTY:

Board adoption of the proposed finding of no significant public interest value for 9 acres (Parcel 139) at the Hat Creek planning unit.

Board adoption of the proposed finding of no significant public interest value for 2 acres (Parcel 133) at the Fall River Mills planning unit.

BUTTE COUNTY:

Board adoption of the proposed finding of no significant public interest value for 6 acres (Parcel 679) at the Oroville planning unit.

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BUTTE AND PLUMAS COUNTIES:

Board adoption of the proposed finding of no significant public interest value for approximately 3 acres (Parcel 667, 667) at the North Fork Feather River planning unit.
