# Mission Statement

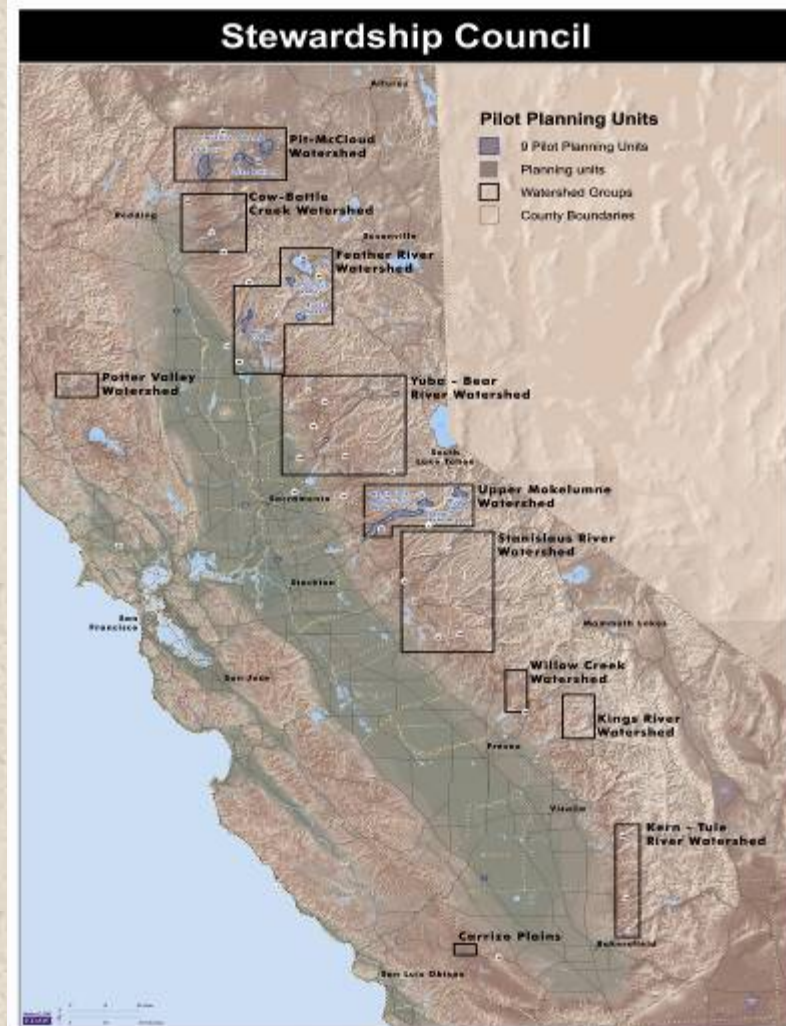
The Stewardship Council protects and enhances watershed lands and uses, and invests in efforts to improve the lives of young Californians through connections with the outdoors.

  - 1000 parcels
  - 22 counties
  - 11 Watersheds
  - 49 Planning Units
- Extensive community outreach effort

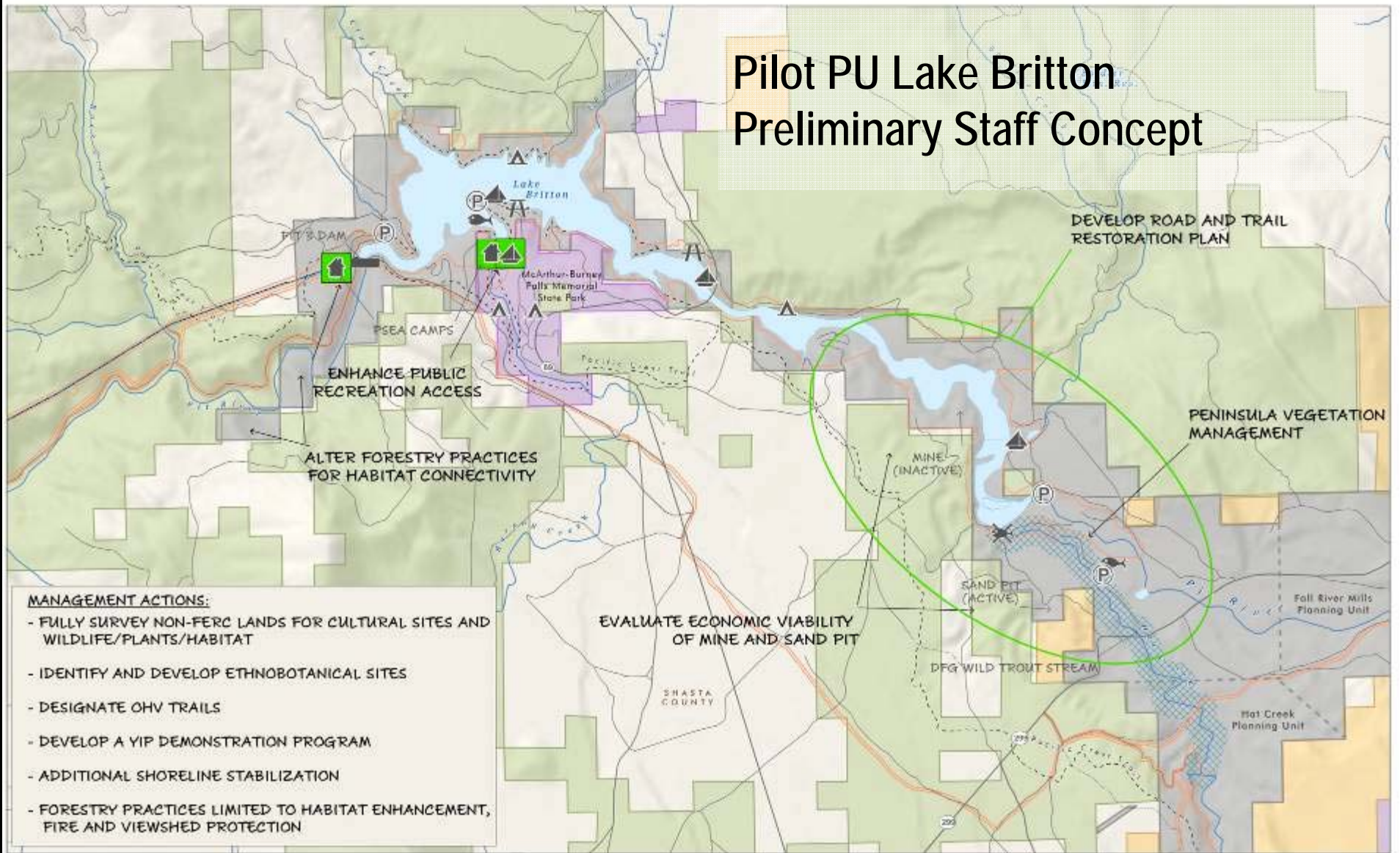


# Land Conservation: Beneficial Public Values
