# Overview Map of Stewardship Council Lands

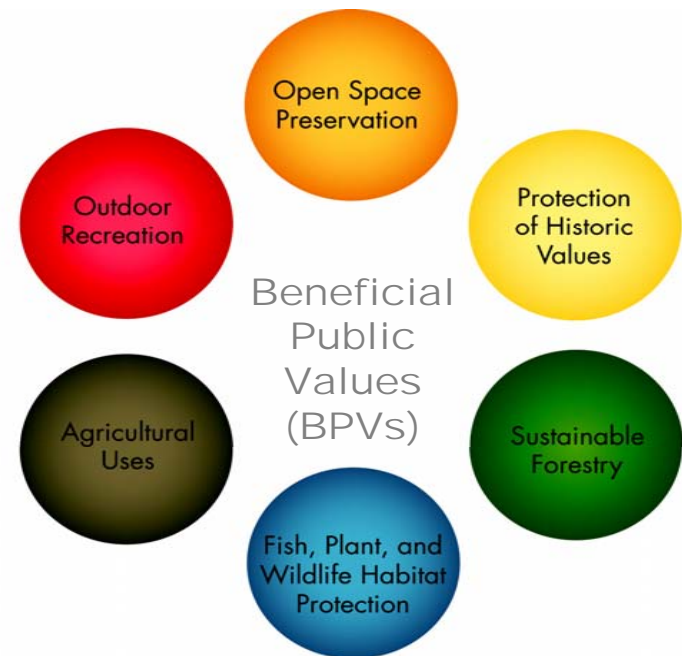


# Land Conservation Plan

  - Land donations/easements
  - Financial grants



# Youth Investment 2007 Grantmaking

- Target of \$2-2.5 million in funding
- Four funds
  - Catalyst—grassroots/start-ups
  - Impact—established/innovative programs
  - Collaboration—field-wide partnerships
  - Infrastructure—parks and playgrounds
- Over \$10 million in proposals to date
