



**STEWARDSHIP COUNCIL BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
TO MEET IN SACRAMENTO ON THURSDAY, JANUARY 21, 2016**

***PUBLIC ENCOURAGED TO ATTEND AND PROVIDE INPUT ON FEE  
RECOMMENDATIONS FOR LANDS IN PLACER, PLUMAS, AND SHASTA  
COUNTIES AND ADOPTION OF LAND CONSERVATION AND CONVEYANCE  
PLANS FOR LANDS IN PLACER AND TUOLUMNE COUNTIES***

**San Mateo, Calif., January 10, 2016** – The Pacific Forest and Watershed Lands Stewardship Council, a land conservation and youth investment foundation, announces its next board of directors meeting will be held in Sacramento on January 21, 2016. The Stewardship Council Board of Directors (Board) may take action on the following agenda items related to its Land Conservation Program, as well as on other matters.

***Fee Title Recommendations***

The specific fee title recommendations made by the Watershed Planning Committee that will be considered by the Board on January 21 are as follows:

**SHASTA COUNTY:**

The Fall River Resources Conservation District is recommended to receive fee title to approximately 18 acres within parcel 137 at the Fall River Mills planning unit.

**PLUMAS COUNTY:**

The Maidu Summit Consortium is recommended to receive fee title to approximately 200 acres within two parcels (parcels 375 and 426) at the Lake Almanor planning unit.

**PLACER COUNTY**

The California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) is recommended to receive fee title to approximately 790 acres within two parcels (parcels 813 and 824) at the Lake Spaulding planning unit.

If the above fee donee recommendations are approved by the Board, transaction negotiations between the parties would commence. The negotiated agreements would become part of a set of proposed Land Conservation and Conveyance Plans (LCCPs) to be considered for adoption by the Board at a later date after an opportunity for public comment. Adoption of an LCCP by the Board would be the final step in the Stewardship Council's process for selecting donees.

**TUOLUMNE COUNTY:** Adoption of the proposed Land Conservation and Conveyance Plan for lands recommended for donation to the U.S. Forest Service at the Lyons Reservoir planning unit.
